Explanation

This explains the functional steps within the sequence. For all the other XML details please refer to [Formats and syntax](#)

- `Playbacks.SetPlaybackLevel` sets a playback to a certain level
- `(this, level:1)` references to the cuelist the macro is triggered from and determines the level to set the fader to (1=100%)
