# Windows.SetWindowProperty.X

```
Void Windows.SetWindowProperty.X(String windowId, Single x-position)
```

<b>API</b>	./.
<b>description</b>	sets a specific window's x position
<b>namespace</b>	<a href="#">Windows.SetWindowProperty</a>
<b>parameter</b>	windowId ( <a href="#">String</a> ) : the Id of the window, see <a href="#">Windows</a> x-position ( <a href="#">Single</a> ) : value from 0 to 2. The whole workspace is 2 units wide and divided into 12 parts.
<b>return value</b>	<a href="#">Void</a>

X, Y, Width and Height are the window's attributes and thus cannot be set with `ActionScript.SetProperty`. Instead, the dedicated functions in the namespace [Windows.SetWindowProperty](#) must be used.
