# Windows.windowId.FixedRows

<b>description</b>	number of button rows the window is supposed to show
<b>Namespaces</b>	<a href="#">Windows.windowId</a>
<b>type</b>	<a href="#">Int32</a>

Strictly this is an element of the respective window.

windowId refers to the workspace window as explained in [Windows](#). This means there are properties like `Windows.Playbacks.FixedRows`, `Windows.Colours.FixedRows` and more

## example

<step>ActionScript.SetProperty.Integer("Windows.Playbacks.FixedRows",  
12)</step>
```

This sets the playbacks window always show 12 button rows.
